Why Early Childhood Education?

Early childhood educators play an important role in a child's development. They inspire young minds, expose them to the joys of learning, and give them the foundation for lifelong success. If you love working with children, the early childhood education program will give you an opportunity to learn about specific tools that help a young child to learn. There is currently a critical shortage of early childhood workers in the state of New Hampshire.

The ECE program at LRCC will provide a theoretical and practical learning experience, thus preparing students to work as an ECE Director, responsible for the care and education of young children, management of personnel, finances, and facilities of an early childhood education program. The certificate prepares graduates to become childcare teachers. Successful completion of this program satisfies New Hampshire Childcare Bureau of Licensing requirements for certification as a childcare director or teacher. This program also provides an ideal preparation for those students wishing to continue their education on the baccalaureate level.

The New Hampshire Bureau of Childcare Standards and Licensing may restrict certification of candidates who have been involved in civil or criminal action.
