Paramedics are highly-trained emergency medical technicians who are qualified to perform a range of medical treatments and life-saving procedures. If you are thinking about a career in healthcare and emergency medicine, and enjoy a fast-paced work environment, you might want to consider a career as a paramedic.

As a paramedic you'll have the opportunity to make a positive impact in someone's life and your community every day. Paramedics provide basic and advanced life support level care, administer medications, and rescue victims from vehicle entrapments and other hazardous environments.

As a Paramedic, you can work

APPLY

- Applicants need current National Registry of EMT or Advanced EMT and CPR certifications.
- Letter of recommendation from their employer.
- Send in high school or college transcripts showing completion of Algebra I with a grade of a C or higher.
- Applicants meeting admission qualifications will be required to interview for the program.
- Proof of vaccinations (see program website for details) and background check are required.
