The Graphic Design program offers a diverse educational experience in all phases of graphic communications. The program exposes the student to a thorough scope of the industry, as well as preparing students to create and run their own freelance businesses.

Students who complete the program will be well-versed in the modern graphics industry, and will have a variety of employment options, such as commercial or promotional needs, packaging, displays, or logos by using modern technologies. Students will create a portfolio of work, as well as complete a Capstone project, which can include an industry internship as a graduation requirement, this allows students to obtain the tools necessary to gain employment in the graphics field.
