## Why Studio Arts?

The Studio Arts track focuses on drawing and painting and also has elective options in printmaking, ceramics, and digital media. Students will leave the program with a sense of their own creative process and a personal website to market themselves and their work to galleries, job prospects or transfer to a four-year program. With this degree a student is prepared for entry into the field or continued education.
